

# JR. FOOD PREPARATION

American System of Judging

1. Refer to “**Notice to Exhibitors**” rules 2&3 for entry due dates.
2. Exhibits must be tagged and in the hands of the Division Heads between 10am & 7pm  
WEDNESDAY.
3. All exhibits must remain in place on the fairgrounds until 5 p.m., SUNDAY.
4. Entry sheet must list type of food. Foods that require refrigeration may not be entered.

RECIPE MUST BE BROUGHT IN AT CHECK-IN

Biscuits, cookies	½ dozen
Candies	½ dozen
Cakes	½ cake plus one slice
Bread	½ loaf or 1 mini-loaf
Pies	4 inch slice or mini-pie

Class 04	Candy
Class 05	Cookies, Chocolate Chip
Class 06	Cookies, Oatmeal

### **Division 731 - DECORATED ITEM**

A mix, Styrofoam or cardboard form may be used to provide the shape in the following 2 classes only.

Class 01	Decorated Cake
Class 02	Decorated item (as sugar mold, gingerbread house, etc.)
Class 03	Decorated Cookie (1) Ages 5-10 - Cookie will be judged on decoration ONLY
Class 04	Decorated Cookie (1) Ages 11-17 - Cookie will be judged on decoration ONLY
