American System of Judging

1. Refer to “**Notice to Exhibitors**” rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. Exhibits must be tagged and in the hands of the Division Heads between 10am & 7pm WEDNESDAY.
3. All exhibits must remain in place on the fairgrounds until 5 p.m., SUNDAY.
4. All entries in these divisions must have been home produced by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair to be eligible for premium awards.
5. Apparel must be secured on hangers.
6. Exhibits must be adequately and correctly labeled, clean and pressed.
