### "TROPHY SADDLE"

To be Awarded to High Point Contestant From the Following Classes

CUTTING CLASS \* - SNAFFLE BIT\* - WORKING COW HORSE\*

RANCH HORSE\*\*(\*\*) - CATTLE PENNING

OPEN TEAM BRANDING – TEAM DOCTORING\*\*\*

**\*Contestant must declare 1 horse per class (Divisions 250-253) to go towards points for saddle. Highest placing out of one of the three Cutting Classes (Division 250) will go towards points for saddle, but horse must be declared on entry form for each class**

**\*\*Contestant must enter Ranch Horse to qualify for saddle**

**\*\*\* Long go points towards saddle only, Top 10 finalists compete for Buckle only**

Highest Points per Individual Per Class

Counts Toward Saddle Only

Points are to be awarded in the following manner:

1st Place	7 Points
2nd Place	6 Points
3rd Place	5 Points
4th Place	4 Points
5th Place	3 Points
6th Place	2 Points

Trophy Saddle tie breaker will be the contestant with the highest **Score** in the **Ranch Horse Class**

Patterns will be posted day of event.

1. Local class rule applies.
2. State Rules, Animal Health Rules and Horse Health Rules applicable to the Senior Department apply to the Junior Department.
3. Contestants displaying any undue roughness with stock will be disqualified.

## **CUTTING**

### **SATURDAY**

**Division 250 CUTTING – LIMIT TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS – Must declare horse for saddle points on entry form**  
*CLARIFICATION NOTATIONS:* A go-around is completed after each horse entered has worked once. Each go-around must be completed before another starts. Exhibitor may enter more than one horse in each class.

Class 01	<b>Open</b>	Entry Fee	\$100.00
Class 02	<b>Non-Pro</b>	Entry Fee	\$80.00
Class 03	<b>Two-Handed</b>	Entry Fee	\$60.00

Horse must be 5 yrs. or younger.

Rider may not have received remuneration for training a cutting horse.

TO BE JUDGED UNDER THE RULES OF THE NATIONAL CUTTING HORSE ASSOCIATION.

**Division 251 - WORKING COW HORSE – LIMIT TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS – Must declare horse for saddle points on entry form**

**SATURDAY**

Class 01 Entry Fee \$65.00

NOTE: Horses to be shown on cattle. No dry work. Out of the herd and down the fence. No tie downs, no hackamore bits, no martingales. If entered in Snaffle Bit Classes must use Snaffle Bit in this class.

**Division 252 RANCH HORSE LIMIT- LIMIT TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS – Must declare horse for saddle points on entry form**

**SATURDAY**

Class 01 Ranch Horse Entry Fee \$80.00

No Dry Work. If animal not roped within the 2 loop, 2.5 time limit, it is an automatic no score.

**Division 253 SNAFFLE BIT- LIMIT TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS – Must declare horse for saddle points on entry form**

**SATURDAY**

Class 01 Snaffle Bit Entry Fee \$65.00

NOTE: Horses 5 yrs. old and younger that have never been worked or shown in full bridle. Horses are not to be shown in any other class of the Stock Horse Division using a bridle. All horses may be mouthed prior to start of class. ABSOLUTELY NO TRAINING DEVICES ALLOWED.

NOTE: Pattern will be posted on day of event

**Division 254-CATTLE PENNING**

**SUNDAY, 12:30 P.M.**

Class 01 Cattle Penning Entry Fee \$150.00

1. Limited to 30 teams.
2. Three (3) person teams
3. Arena will be in 1/3 areas
4. Each team will have 3 head of numbered cattle cut out of herd. Cattle can only be cut from herd and removed between the barrels.
5. No more than 4 head of cattle can be past the barrel line at one time.
6. Undesignated cattle must be returned to the 1/3 herd area before the contestants' time is stopped seconds before time ends.
7. Only one person in the herd at a time.
8. There will be a 3 min. time limit. (Warning whistle will blow 30 seconds before time ends). After whistle, contestants may pen 3 or less head.
9. The Judge's decision is final.

**TEAM BRANDING**

1. All team members MUST be listed on same entry form and captain stated.
2. Entry fee for entire team must accompany form.
3. Mixed Team Branding does not count toward points for the Trophy Saddle.

**Division 255-OPEN TEAM BRANDING**

**SUNDAY, 12:30 P.M.**

Class 01          Entry Fee          \$400.00

4 Person Team/4 Calves/6 min time. Each team member must rope, be on ground, and on horse.

**Division 256 -MIXED TEAM BRANDING**

**SUNDAY, 12:30 P.M.**

Class 01          Entry Fee          \$225.00

Each team consists of 2 women and 2 men.

1 man and 1 woman must rope together.

2 must be on ground, 2 on horseback.

Brand 2 calves, 4 minute time limit.

**Division 257 – TEAM DOCTORING**

**SUNDAY, 8:00 A.M.**

Class 01          Entry Fee          \$200.00

Each team consists of 4 persons

1. Arena divided into herd area (east of barrels) and working area (west of barrels)
2. Drawn number given as starting flag is dropped.
3. Riders will cut ONE of the designated numbered cows out of herd.
4. Cows only cut from herd and removed between barrels.
5. Only one person in herd at a time
6. None of the herd cattle can leave the herd area of arena.
7. Header cannot throw loop until cow has passed barrels and in working area. Cow must be headed in working area.
8. Designated cow cannot return herd area once through barrels
9. Legal head catches only (neck or neck and 1 front foot o.k.)
10. Illegal head catch **cannot** be dallied.
11. Loop limit is **4**.
12. Designated cow can be heeled in the working area of the arena.
13. "Vets" leaves horse after cow is heeled.
14. "Vets" then sets ropes on both front and hind feet. Then places mark on cow between eyes and raises arms to signal end of work.
15. Time starts when rider crosses start line.
16. Time Limit is **2 minutes**.
17. **Top 10 teams return Sunday afternoon to determine buckle winners.**
18. Judge's decision is final.
