BAKING

1. Refer to “**Notice to Exhibitors**” rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. Exhibit must be tagged and in the hands of the Division Heads between 10:00 am and 7pm WEDNESDAY.
3. All exhibits must remain in place on the grounds until 5 p.m., SUNDAY.
4. All entries in these Divisions must be home prepared by the exhibitor.
5. NO PACKAGED MIXES.
6. Any other and all variety, name variety on entry form.

4. Pie may be baked in any type of pie plate.
5. Pie must have a top and bottom crust and the filling must be made from fresh apples
ONLY.
6. Pie must be made from scratch.
7. Recipe to accompany entry.
