EXHIBITORS MUST BE BONA FIDE OWNERS OF ALL ENTRIES 30 DAYS

1. Refer to "Notice to Exhibitors" rules 2 & 3 for entry due dates.
2. All livestock will be accepted throughout the day on THURSDAY. Sheep will be weighed-in between the hours of 5pm and 7pm, THURSDAY.

3. All sheep must remain on the fairgrounds until 5 pm SUNDAY. Registration papers must accompany either the entry forms or the sheep to the fairgrounds.
4. Registration papers must be checked in at the Livestock Office by 9 am FRIDAY and any deficiencies cleared at that time.
5. Market and feeder sheep will be unloaded at the scales upon arrival at the fairgrounds in order to obtain weights for proper entry classes.
6. All animals in group entries must be of one breed in All Other Breeds Class.
7. Pen and Flock classes can be shown but not required.
8. Exhibitors please watch for pedestrians.

Rules, definitions and Judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders' Association, Inc., shall apply to all District Fair Rabbit Shows, provided they do not conflict with Department of Food and Agriculture.

1. Refer to "Notice to Exhibitors" rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. Rabbits will be accepted between the hours of 1 pm and 3 pm, THURSDAY. No rabbits will be accepted prior to this time. All rabbits must be in place by 3 pm, THURSDAY.
3. All rabbits must remain on the fairgrounds until 5:00 pm, Sunday, and **MUST BE REMOVED** by 7 pm.
4. Cages will be furnished by the Fair. Exhibitors will furnish their own watering containers. Feed and feeder shall be supplied by Exhibitor.
5. All animals must be identified by permanent ear markings conforming with the entry form on arrival at the show. ALL TATTOOING IS TO BE DONE PRIOR TO FAIR. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same Division must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging begins.
6. Health Inspector's decision is final. Disqualification from show will be the result of any infringement or argument regarding this rule. No medication is to be used that in any way alters the appearance or performance of the animal.
7. The age in MONTHS (i.e. 4 months ) must be stated on the entry form for each animal entered.
8. EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO BE PRESENT DURING JUDGING unless prior arrangements are made with Show Management. All state and local rules apply.
9. Trophies will be awarded in divisions with 3 or more entries.

*American System of Judging*

Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of American Poultry Association, shall apply to all District Fair Poultry Shows, provided they do not conflict with Department of Food and Agriculture.

1. Refer to “**Notice to Exhibitors**” rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. **All poultry will be inspected by a certified Poultry Health Inspector prior to entering the Poultry/Rabbit Barn. Inspections and check in are between 1:00pm and 3:00pm Thursday at the south end of the horse stalls near the livestock gate. Poultry will be inspected individually and may not be allowed on the grounds if disqualified.**
3. All animals must remain on the fairgrounds until 5:00 pm Sunday.
4. Health Inspector’s decision is final. Disqualification from show will be the result of any infringement or argument regarding this rule. No medication is to be used that in any way alters the appearance or performance of the animal.
5. Limited number of cages will be furnished by the fair and assigned by the livestock office. Cages are available on a first come, first serve basis. In the event cages are full, exhibitor will furnish own cage. Exhibitor will furnish own watering containers, feed and feeders.
6. All State and local rules apply.
7. Birds will be shown & judged in the proper division & class for breed & variety, age & sex only. If no class is offered no award will be made.
8. Judge may excuse a bird from competition if it appears to be fatigued or out of condition.
9. All birds must be identified by leg bands and indicated on entry forms.
10. No more than 2 premium moneys per class will be paid to Exhibitor.
11. **EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO BE PRESENT DURING JUDGING** unless prior arrangements are made with Show Management.
