AMERICAN SYSTEM OF JUDGING

1. Refer to "Notice to Exhibitors" rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. **All livestock will be accepted throughout the day THURSDAY.** Cattle will be weighed in between 5pm and 7 p.m. **Cattle can be accepted prior to this time IF arrangements are made in advance.**
3. Registration papers must be presented and checked in at the livestock office by 9 a.m., FRIDAY and any and all deficiencies cleared at this time.
4. Cattle must remain on the fairgrounds until 5:00 p.m., SUNDAY.
5. Exhibitors must be the bona fide owners of all entries for 60 days prior to date of the Fair.

Note: When making an entry in group classes, enter cow on one line and calf on the next line. Identify both animals by birth date and registration numbers. If calf is not old enough to show as an individual and does not have a registration number, be sure to give birth date of calf, permanent identification and registration number of its sire and dam.

GRADE OR PUREBRED ANIMALS – BY PUREBRED SIRE

By signature as the owner or agent on an entry form, the exhibitor also certifies that the sire of each animal entered in the following classes for grade animals was either registered or purebred.

MARKET BEEF SCORECARD

GRADE

Group 1: Animals grading USDA Prime or Choice, demonstrating youthfulness size for age, muscling and superior conformation of a yield Grade 1 or 2 carcass. **BLUE RIBBON**

Group 2: Animals grading USDA Prime or Choice, having average cutability and average conformation. Yield Grade 3. **RED RIBBON**

Group 3: Animals grading USDA Select + with superior conformation and will produce superior carcass. Yield Grade 1 or 2. **WHITE RIBBON**

All Breeds judged together. All Market Beef must be individually owned by the exhibitor for 120 days prior to the opening day of the fair.
