OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

All cars must register at the pit gate the day of the event. Registration will start at 4PM and must be completed by 6PM. All vehicles must pass inspection before being allowed to compete and may be re-inspected at any time.

FEES: Car and driver \$45.00, pit crew members \$15.00 each.

All drivers must be 18 years of age and be able to verify age.

Pit crew members must be 18 years old, except for a child of the driver, who must be 14 years old.

Maximum of 3 pit crew members per car.

No one under 18 years of age will be allowed in the pit area except for a registered pit crew member that is a child of a driver.

Drivers and pit crew members' age will be checked, so have your ID.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA. ICE CHESTS AND VEHICLES WILL BE CHECKED AND ANYONE FOUND WITH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PITS.

No glass containers are allowed in the pit area.

Violation of any of these rules may result in the disqualification of the car and driver. Disqualified cars and drivers will be removed from the event site. The decision of the event judges and officials will be final.

Any verbal abuse or threats to the judges or event officials by anyone signed in with any car will result in disqualification of the car and driver.

In order to participate in the main event and entry must be in at least one heat race and not have been disqualified.

Vehicle placing in any event may be subject to re-inspection before the main event.

Heats will be 20 minutes or less as determined by the officials. Heat order will be determined by a draw during the pit meeting. The main event will have no time limit. The last car running will be the winner.

Each event will be started with each car placing its front end to the outside of the arena. Events will start with the sound of a siren and the waving of a green flag. If the siren sounds and the red lights come on during an event all action will stop immediately.

Any driver found to be sandbagging by the judges will be disqualified.

Cars stalled/disabled for more than three minutes will not be allowed to finish the event but will be allowed to compete in the main event. Cars stalled/disabled for more than three minutes in the main event will not be allowed to finish the event

No driver is permitted to unbuckle their seat belts or remove their helmet during any event and must remain in their car until the event is over, except in the case of an emergency.

No intentional collisions permitted on the driver's door!!! Immediate disqualification will result from violation of this rule.

Head on collisions will be permitted.

Derby cars will carry a white flag. If your car is disabled, wave the white flag. Once you displayed the white flag you are out of that heat.

TECHNICAL RULES

1. Seat belts and D.O.T. helmets are required for all drivers.
2. Drivers and pit crew must wear a minimum of 50% white or easily visible clothing (white shirt or white pants).
3. Car numbers must be painted on the roof and both front doors. The numbers must be at least 24 inches in height. No profanity painted on your car and no flags or other materials attached to the car's exterior.
4. Inspections will take place at the time of registration and the car may be re-inspected at any time.
5. No reinforcing of the car will be permitted, unless allowed by the rules. **THIS INCLUDES ANY WELDING ON OR REINFORCING OF THE FRAME OR BODY SEAMS AND PANELS IN ANY WAY NOT SPECIFICALLY OUTLINED.**
6. All flammable materials must be removed, with the exception of the driver's seat.
7. All glass, chrome strips, plastic, molding, lettering, pot metal, grills, lights, lenses, etc. must be removed.
8. Fenders may be cut away six inches from the tires.
9. Gas tanks must be securely anchored in the rear seat area, with no more than 5 gallons in the tank. The stock gas tank must be removed from the original location. Gas tanks such as jerry cans or the like are permitted. **No plastic containers or plastic fittings.**
10. Hole must be made in the floorboard around the gas tank for possible spillage.
11. Gasoline is the only fuel allowed. Starting fluid is not permitted in the car during the running of the event.

12. Radiators must be in the original stock position. No extra heater core or radiators allowed.
13. Transmission coolers or transmission cold cans must be located in the rear seat area and be securely mounted.
14. More than one battery is permitted. All batteries must be securely anchored in the passenger area and completely covered with rubber (inner tube type material).
15. Batteries must be removed from the engine compartment. No electric fuel pumps allowed without a separate shut-off switch!!!!(FIRE HAZARD).
16. Doors may be chained or welded (**NOT BOTH**). If welded; 12" of weld per seam, filler not to exceed ½" stock. If chained, chain size may not exceed ½".
17. Driver's door may be welded solid. Driver's door may be filled with concrete for driver safety.
18. Bumpers must be stock; they may be welded to the bumper brackets. Bumper brackets may be welded to the frame. No filler or added material, no bumper seam welding, 5mph bumpers may have the shocks welded or may be installed using 3"x12"x1/2" maximum square tubing, welded on the outside of the frame only, not on top, bottom, inside or stuffed in the frame. **NO WELDING OF THE BUMPER TO THE BODY.**
19. Welding of the hood is not allowed. The hood must be chained or secured with no more than 4 bolts or pins. Bolts or pins may not be larger than 5/8" and washers may not exceed 3" in diameter and ¼" in thickness. No more than two chains allowed on the hood. Chain size may not exceed ½" and may not be longer than 3' per chain. A hole no larger than 12 x 12 inches must be cut in the center of the hood to provide fire extinguisher access.
20. Trunk lid may be chained, bolted or welded; 24" of weld maximum. No frame contact. Chain may wrap bumper in two places. ½" chain max with length not to exceed 3' per chain. Bolts may not exceed

- 5/8" in diameter with washer no larger than 3" in diameter and 1/4" thickness. **NO MORE THAN 4 BOLTS.**
21. Station wagon deck lid must be removed, tailgate may be chained or welded 24" of weld max. Chain 1/2" max.
 22. Roll bars are for driver protection only. Cross bracing between the doors is optional. Bracing options are outlined in a diagram on the following page.
 23. Engines may be chained or bolted to the frame. No engine mounts forward of the engine block. Only one engine mount per side.
 24. U.S. made cars only. Hard top model stock cars, including station wagons are okay. No pick-ups or four wheel drive allowed. Foreign cars made in the U.S. are not allowed.
 25. No alterations of the frame horn is permitted. No alteration of the springs or suspension is allowed, front or rear.
 26. Bumper heights, front and rear, will not be higher than 20" measured from the ground to the bottom of the bumper. Car may be raised to this height. Spring spacers are the only accepted method for lifting. Previously run car heights will be determined by officials.
 27. Driver seats must be securely anchored to the frame and shall have a back rest. Shoulder harnesses are allowed, along with seatbelts.
 28. No trailer hitches are allowed.
 29. A 2 1/2 pound (net weight) ABC fire extinguisher, fully charged, properly mounted in the car within the drivers reach is required.
 30. Only stock tires with highway tread are permitted on the drive axles. Air filled only, stock mounting. Mud and snow tires are not allowed on drive axles. Mud and snow tire will be allowed on non-drive axles. Tire chains or other traction devices are not allowed.
 31. **MANDATORY:** Windshield braces from the top of the opening to prevent hood from entering the car.

32.Body mounts bolts must be in stock location.

33.Engine must be in the stock location.

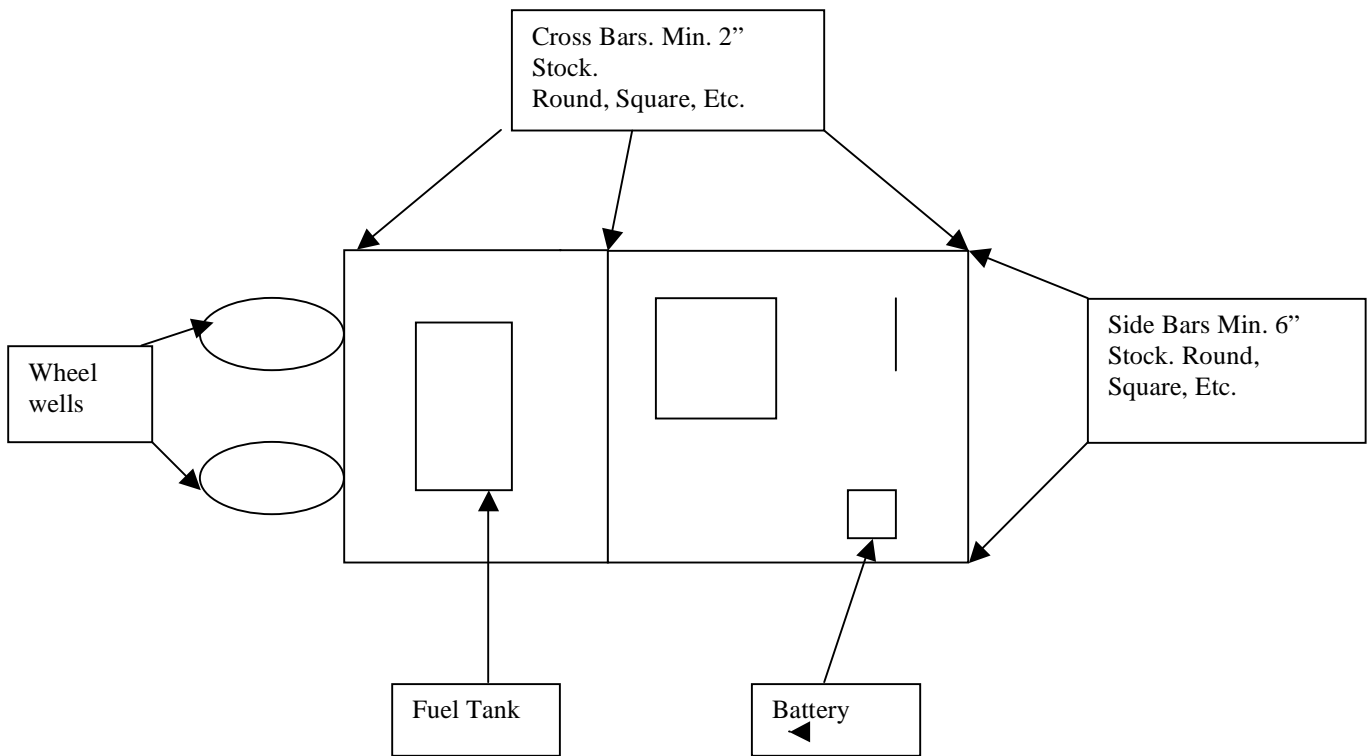
