2. Exhibits must be tagged and in the hands of the Division Heads by 7 pm, WEDNESDAY. NOTE: Exhibits will NOT be accepted before 10:00 am WEDNESDAY.
3. All exhibits in this department must NOT have been previously shown at the Modoc District Fair.
4. All entries must be framed or matted and wired for hanging.
5. Labels must be affixed to the back upper left hand corner. This must be done prior to delivery. Labels must show name of artist, Division and Class numbers.
6. No copies or “Paint by Numbers” type of pictures are accepted.
7. Management reserves the right to withhold or reject any exhibits in this department. All work will be judged even though it may not be displayed.
8. Modoc District Fair will take every precaution possible for the safety of all entries. However, the fair assumes no responsibility and cannot be held accountable for loss or damage which may occur from any cause, and upon this condition only are entries accepted.

# **CHANGES IN PHOTOGRAPHY!**

## **SENIOR PHOTOGRAPHY**

American System of Judging

**AMATEUR:** Engages in photography as a hobby, is not otherwise paid for engaging in photography except for cash prizes for premium awards.

**PROFESSIONAL:** Engages in photography as a business, sales exceed the cost of materials.

1. Refer to “**Notice to Exhibitors**” rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. Exhibits must be tagged and in the hands of the Division Heads by 7 p.m., WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19. NOTE: Exhibits will NOT be accepted before **9:00 a.m.** WEDNESDAY.
3. The use of wood, metal or glass is not permitted in mounting.
4. All entries shall be clearly marked on the back of mount:
  - a. Name and Address of Exhibitor
  - b. Title of Print-**must match entry form**
  - c. Div/Class under which the print is entered.
5. Prints must not be framed.
6. (Amateurs)All prints must be mounted on white paper with 1” border or matted. Tape, glue or white picture mounting holders for pictures on paper is acceptable. The finished size shall not exceed 10”x 12”. Matting is required for the professional division.
7. All exhibits in this department must NOT have been previously shown at the Modoc District Fair.
8. The picture must have been taken by the exhibitor (No internet downloads).
9. Any finish is acceptable. (Professionals).
10. The developing and processing of negatives and prints by the exhibitor or commercial plant is acceptable.
11. **NOTICE:** *All pictures will be hung with push pins.*
12. **LIMIT** Exhibitor limited to 5 entries per class.

5. All exhibits in this department must NOT have been previously shown at the Modoc District Fair.
6. The picture must have been taken by the exhibitor (No internet downloads).
7. Any finish is acceptable.
8. The photo size shall not exceed 16" x 20" and must be framed.
9. **LIMIT:** Exhibitor limited to 3 entries per class.
