SPECIMEN - CUT FLOWER DIVISIONS

Definitions:

Bloom - An individual flower, one blossom to a stem.

Spike-A stalk carrying many stemless or nearly stemless flowers.

Spray - A portion of a plant with a number of flowers on one stem.

Stalk - Stiff stem, which may branch, with one or more flowers.

Disbudded - Removal of the lateral buds along the stem of the flower.

5. Exhibits must be arranged in at least 3 containers and does not need to be proportional to fence.
6. The Mini Booth must be completed by Thursday at 11:00 am.
