American System of Judging Extended Classes

*EXHIBITORS MUST BE THE BONA FIDE OWNERS OF ALL EXHIBITS 120 DAYS*

1. Entries close FRIDAY, August 7, 2009
2. Horse must be on the fairgrounds by 7:00 AM, THURSDAY. Horses not on grounds at this time may be eliminated.
3. Any deficiencies on entries must be cleared in the livestock office before judging. Registration papers are not necessary.
4. Exhibitor will not be subject to a drug fee. However, each horse may be subject to random testing to determine the presence of drugs that may alter the performance or disposition of the animal.
5. STALLS will be reserved ONLY if stall is sent with entry form. ALL STALLS: \$20.00 each for duration of Fair.
6. Junior exhibitors (under 18 years of age) will be allowed to enter stallions, but will not be allowed to show the stallions.

# SENIOR HORSE SHOW

18 Years and Older Extended Classes

STATE RULES I THRU XI APPLY WHERE THERE IS NO CONFLICT WITH LOCAL RULES.

1. Entries close on FRI, AUG. 7, 2009 at 6 pm. **NO POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED** in any Horse Show Departments. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS. NO PHONE OR FAX ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** ENTRY FORMS received without fees will not be entered until fees are received and received by 6 pm August 7, 2009.
2. Horse and rider must be on the fairgrounds one hour prior to scheduled class. Horses and riders not on grounds at this time may be eliminated.
3. Any deficiencies in entries must be cleared in the LIVESTOCK OFFICE BEFORE JUDGING BEGINS
4. Exhibitor will be not be subject to a drug fee, however, each horse may be subject to random testing to determine the presence of drugs that may alter the performance or disposition of the animal.
5. A Junior Exhibitor will be allowed to enter the Senior Horse Show only when a class for the exhibit is not provided in the Junior Horse Show Department.
6. THURSDAY HORSE SHOW ONLY: The same horse may **NOT** be ridden in BOTH the Junior Department and the Open Senior Department
7. Unless other rules are specified, rules and definitions for conducting each class as contained in the Rule Books of the A.Q.H.A. and the American Horse Show Association, Inc., will apply to this Horse Show provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
8. No drug fees.
9. **All entrants must wear a long sleeve shirt and western hat.**
10. Exhibitors shall keep horses north of concession stand during stallion class.

## HIGH POINT AWARD CRITERIA

Class is accumulation of points in Horsemanship Division. Must enter Class 7 to be eligible.
