State Rules I thru XI Apply to this Department

Notice: No Vehicles, stock trailers, etc. will be allowed to park in or near barns, stalls, track and arena Thursday through Sunday. **Mounted Riders please respect pedestrian traffic.**

1. Entries close on FRI. AUG. 7, 2009 at 6 pm. **NO POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED** in any Horse Show Departments. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS. NO PHONE OR FAX ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** ENTRY FORMS received without fees will not be entered until fees are received and received by 6 pm August 7, 2009.
2. Horses and riders must be on the fairgrounds 1 hour prior to scheduled class. Horses not on the grounds at this time may be eliminated.
3. Any deficiencies in entries must be cleared in the LIVESTOCK OFFICE BEFORE JUDGING BEGINS.
4. NOTICE: The State of California allows no medication or drugs that alter the performance of the horse. Any medication or drugs used that might still be detected at time of show must be reported to Horse Show Secretary prior to the beginning of show. Exhibitors found in violation of rule or in practices unethical or inimical shall be penalized and reported to the State. This report is used as a basis for refusal of entries at other shows.
5. Eliminations will be used if necessary. Time set prior to show date.
6. No child can enter more than one horse in any one event.
7. One child may ride the same horse in all classes, but the same horse CANNOT be used in the same class more than once. The horse cannot be exchanged in a class for another child to ride. THURSDAY HORSE SHOW ONLY-The same horse may not be ridden in BOTH the Junior Department and the Open Senior Department (with the exception of Pleasure Horse 8 and under.)
8. No stallions to be ridden or shown by Juniors.
9. Juniors entering the Senior Horse Show may not enter the same divisions of the Junior Horse Show. A Junior Exhibitor will be allowed to enter the Senior Horse Show only when a class for the exhibit is not provided in the Junior Horse Show Department.
10. STALLS will be reserved ONLY if stall fee is sent with entry form. ALL STALLS: \$20.00 each.
11. Unless other rules are specified, rules and definitions of conduction for each class are contained in the Rule Books of the A.Q.H.A. or the USA Equestrian Association, Inc., and will apply to this Horse Show provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by Department of Food and Ag.
12. Management must divide classes of 50 or more, however, Management at its discretion, may divide classes of 15 or more.
13. All Classes Limited to Exhibitors 19 yrs. old and younger (On JAN.1,2009) unless otherwise noted.
14. Junior horse exhibitors in Junior horse events must wear a long sleeved shirt & helmet in mounted competition. In the event that the exhibitor chooses to wear a western hat, a liability waiver must be signed & filed at the livestock office. Form is available at the livestock office.

JUNIOR STILL EXHIBITS

INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS: All entries must have been made, collected or prepared by the exhibitor in accordance with the requirements of recommendations of that project program. Entries that require packaging and labeling, such as food preservation, must be done in accordance with directions and recipes in project manuals and outlines. Check carefully the recommendations for kind and size of container, and method of labeling. Only standard containers, specifically designed for the purpose will be accepted.

1. Refer to “**Notice to Exhibitors**” rules 2&3 for entry dates.
2. Exhibits must be tagged and in the hands of the Division Heads between 10am & 7pm WEDNESDAY, Floriculture, tagged WED.12-7pm, THURS. 7-11am.
3. Each entry in these divisions shall have been made or produced by the exhibitor. **The signature of a parent, guardian, leader or teacher is required on the entry form**
4. All pictures, drawings, etc., must be mounted on poster board or construction paper and ready to be displayed. **Exhibitor’s name, address MUST be written on back side of entry.**
5. All entries in these divisions must NOT have been previously shown at Modoc District Fair. Exhibits may be shown at other fairs within a 12 month period.
